Justified by Faith — marking guide

Use this to mark your own worksheet. For reflection questions, there is no single right answer — check that your response genuinely engages with the passage.

1. According to Galatians 2:16, how is a person justified (made right with God)?

By faith in Jesus Christ, not by the works of the law.

2. What does Paul mean when he says, 'I am crucified with Christ... yet not I, but Christ liveth in me' (Galatians 2:20)?

Accept answers about the old self dying and a new identity/life being shaped by Christ living within the believer.

3. According to Galatians 3:26-28, what unites all believers regardless of background?

Faith in Christ Jesus — there is neither Jew nor Greek, bond nor free, male nor female; all are one in Christ.

4. What does Galatians 3:29 say believers become, through belonging to Christ?

Heirs, according to God's promise to Abraham.

5. Reflection: What difference does it make to think of being made right with God as a gift of faith rather than something earned?
